

# GUIDELINES 

Munday Events Center January 15, 2021

## General Rules

1. To be eligible for the sale, the student who made the project must be passing the previous grade period. (UIL Rules)
2. All items must be checked in with the leader assigned to that division at the project area on Friday, January 15th, by 8:30 am.
3. The organization and individuals listed in the coordinating committee are not responsible for loss, damage, or injury to exhibits or exhibitors.
4. Committee members are not responsible for items left on display after the pick up time, Saturday, January 16th, at 11:00 am.
5. There will be three age groups divided by grades:

- K—2nd Grade - Clover Kids
- 3rd-8th Grade - Junior Division
- 9th—12th Grade - Senior Division

6. 1st-5th Place ribbons will be given in each class. Participation ribbons will be given through 2nd grade.
7. Rosettes will be awarded to the category winners in each age group. Blue rosette winners will be chosen from 1st place ribbons in each class.
8. All exhibits must have been made within the 365 days preceding the Project Fair. Special exceptions are made to Ag. Mechanics.
9. The exhibitor may enter as many articles as desired but only one entry in each class.
10.The overall Junior and Senior winning entries will each will receive a monetary award. To make the premium sale, an exhibitor in the project show must be a $4-\mathrm{H}$, FFA or FCCLA member.

## General Rules (Cont.)

11.Superintendents will have final say in all category interpretation.
12.Name must be concealed on all entries.
13.If rules are not followed, entry will not be placed.

## FOOD

14. All food entries must be prepared "from scratch".
15. No baked goods that require refrigeration will be allowed.
16. Preserved foods must be labeled with date of preservation. Standard canning jars are required.
17. All items must be on display on sturdy disposable plates or containers and covered in clear plastic wrap/plastic zip-top bag. No returnable containers (glass, ceramic, etc.) are permitted.
18. Participants are not required to exhibit the entire recipe. A recipe that makes 3 loaves of bread, requires only 1 loaf. Or a recipe that makes 3 dozen cookies, only requires 6 cookies. A complete copy of the recipe is REQUIRED for the entry.

## PHOTOGRAPHY

19. Framing and/or mounting is not required and will not be scored.
20. Photographs must be at least 5 " x 7 ".

## TEXTILES

21. All entries must be clean and on a hanger.
22.Machine Division consists of items made using some type of machine.
(Example: Sewing machine, embroidery machine, etc.)
23.Handwork Division - must be done by hand, no machine work.

*Must utilize some form of machine (embroidery, sewing, etc.)

- Class \#6: Other


## Handwork Division

*Items must use some form of textile (fabric, yarn, or fiber) and be completed by hand (no machine work permitted)

- Class \#7: Quilts
- Class \#8: Crocheted Items
- Class \#9: Knitted Items
- Class \#10: Counted Cross Stitch
- Class \#11: Embroidery
- Class \#12: Weaving
- Class \#13: Other

## Foods Category (Yellow)

## Baked Goods Division

- Class \#14: Cookies (6 cookies)
- Class \#15: Cakes (1 cake)
- Class \#16: Cupcakes (6 cupcakes)
- Class \#17: Candy (6 pieces)
- Class \#18: Quick Bread (1 loaf)
- Class \#19: Yeast Bread (1 loaf)
- Class \#20: Pies (1 pie)
- Class \#21: Other


## Canned, Preserved, or Novelty Goods Division

- Class \#22: Vegetables, Fruits
- Class \#23: Pickles
- Class \#24: Jellies/Jams/Marmalades/Preserves
- Class \#25: Sauces/Relish
- Class \#26: Other

*5" $\times 7$ " minimum, may be black and white and/or color

- Class \#40: Still Life

( $60 \%$ of project must be made from some type of wood)
